- Be polite while using technology. I won't write mean or hurtful messages.
- Tell my teacher if I read or see something that is inappropriate.
- Not give my full name, address, phone number or other personal information online.
- Respect the privacy of others. I won't try to discover anyone else's password or other private information.
- Obey my teacher's instructions and visit only allowed websites.
- While at school, I will use technology to increase my learning and not for playing non-educational games.
